

Is a handsome ancient edifice, the living of which is a vicarage, in the patronage of the Marquis of Hastings (who is lord of the manor) and in the incumbency of the Rev. William M'Douall. The other places of worship are, a chapel each for the independents, Wesleyan methodists and calvinists. Here is an endowed free school, founded in 1567, by Henry Earl of Huntingdon; a blue-coat school, founded by Isaac Dawson, in 1669; and a green-coat school, endowed by Alderman Newton, of Leicester. Within the distance of four miles from the town are several collieries: fire bricks are manufactured to a considerable extent; and the wolds abound with fine

The source of the river Mease is in this parish, which runs at the bottom of the town; the Ashby canal to Coventry passes through the parish; and there are several springs, the Hobywell, especially, is a remarkably fine and copious one, romantically situated. The land in the neighbourhood is fertile, both for grazing and corn. The market-day is on Saturday; and there are five fairs in the year, viz., Shrove-Monday, Easter-Tuesday, Whitsun-Tuesday, the last Monday in September, and November 10th, principally for horses and cattle, and the hiring servants. In 1821 the parish contained 3,937 inhabitants.
