is a handsome ancient edifice, the living of which is a vicarage, in the patronage of the Marquis of Hastings (who is lord of the manor) and in the incumbency of the Rev. William M'Douall. The other places of worship are, a chapel each for the independents, Wesleyan methodists and calvinists. Here is an endowed free school, founded in 1567, by Henry Eart of Huntingdon; a blue-coat school, founded by Saturday; and there are five fairs in the year, viz., Isaac Dawson, in 1669; and a green-coat school, conded by Alderman Newton, of Leicester. Within the distance of four miles from the town are several collieries; fire bricks are manufactured to a considerable extent; and the wolds abound with fine siderable extent; and the wolds abound with fine tants.
